Before you begin this process, collect all copies of your transcript(s), and MCAT score(s) in .PDF or .jpeg format. Official transcripts aren't needed for this application.

Letters of recommendation(s) (LORs) should be sent separately via email by the letter writer. **Direct letter writers to send all LORs to diversity@med.wayne.edu.** Letter writers should include YOURNAME in the email subject line your name. See the example below. Ex. JessicaRabbitLOR

Your application is not complete until your LORs are received. Please complete all fields in the application. All requested documents must be submitted with the application. Late or incomplete applications will not receive further consideration. All materials must be submitted by March 31st, 2022. Your complete responses will allow program administrators to conduct a holistic review of candidates. If you pause your application on the Internet, return to the original link to continue. While this application is formatted to view on a mobile device, it is best completed on computer to allow upload and written responses to be completed.
